THE ELGEYO/MARAKWET COUNTY FINANCE BILL, 2014

Bill for

AN ACT of the County Assembly of Elgeyo/Marakwet to provide for the revenue raising measures of the county government of Elgeyo/Marakwet for the year 2014/2015 and for connected purposes

ENACTED by the County Assembly of Elgeyo/Marakwet as follows;

PART I—PRELIMINARY

Short title and commencement. **1.** (1) This Act may be cited as the Elgeyo/Marakwet County Finance Act, 2014 and shall, subject to section 2(2), come into operation on such a date as the County Executive Committee Member for Finance may appoint and different dates may be appointed for different provisions

(2) The respective taxes, fees and charges, together with the rates applicable shall take effect in not later than three months after the commencement of this Act.

**PART II— FEES AND TAXES PAYABLE AND RATES
APPLICABLE**

Interpretation **2.** (1) The taxes, fees and charges set out in the Schedule shall apply for the respective services and at the rates set out therein.

(2) For greater certainty, the taxes, fees and charges applicable at the commencement of this Act shall continue to apply under the existing by-laws of the defunct Councils of Elgeyo/Marakwet until such by-laws are repealed and replaced by county legislation.

(3) For purposes of Iten Township, the rates, fees and

charges payable under section 2 shall be applicable to all business being operated within a radius of three (3) kilometers from the central business district.

| Application of transitional provision | 6. If any national Act mentioned in the Schedule has not been amended to provide for the imposition of the fees or charges for services by the county government, then paragraph 7 of the Sixth Schedule of the Constitution applies in relation to that Act. |
| Fees and charges authorized by contracts etc. | 7. For avoidance of doubt, nothing in this Act is to be taken to prevent a county government from entering into a contract or agreement or other arrangement to provide a service upon payment of a fee or charge |

MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

County Assembly standing Orders, in particular, standing order No. 218 which requires the County Finance Bill to be presented to the County assembly as a legislative proposal to be acted upon by the assembly.

The Bill seeks to provide for the various taxes, fees, levies and other services charges that are payable to the Elgeyo/Marakwet County Government.

These set out in the schedules to the bill.

The first schedule is in respect of the department of the departmental fees and charges whereas the second schedule is in respect of single Business permits with applications fee. The said schedules also sets out the rates in Kenya shillings (Kshs) currently payable to the County Government so that it is possible to assess the changes that take into account the need to enhance the payable revenue for better service delivery and to enable the County Government perform the increased functions bestowed on it by the fourth schedule of the Constitution of Kenya.

Statement on delegate powers to legislate the Executive Committee member responsible for finance and economic planning empowered to bring into operation the various provisions of the Act and the Schedules or certain sections thereof. This is to enable the putting in place of necessary physical, administration and personnel, infrastructure that would and in the operationalisation of the collection of the proposed taxes, fees and charges.

The operationalisation of certain provision of the proposed law shall entail on expenditure of public funds will be provided for in the estimates.
